Experience God's Land ... Israel Day 1 – Wed. Feb 21 (Travel) ~ Day 2 – Thurs. Feb 22 (Arrive)

You must arrange for your flights to and from Israel. Please arrange to arrive the afternoon of the 22nd. We will gather at the *Netanya Leonardo Hotel* in Netanya for our evening meal on the 22nd Following the meal, we will have our first group meeting and you will receive your personal audio receiver for the tour. Note: Please send us your flight information, including your arrival time in Israel. If several arrive about the same time, we will try to arrange for a van to the hotel. If not, please plan to take a taxi to our hotel.

"Welcome Home" to God's Land, Israel!

~ En route to the hotel, you will skirt **Tel Aviv**, the *"beautiful new 100-year-old city"*. One could spend weeks visiting the museums of this incredible Jewish city. **Our tour is a Biblical one.** We overnight at the **Leonardo Hotel**, **Netanya**, by the **Mediterranean Sea**.

Day 3 – Feb 23 – Friday MEDITERRANEAN COAST / MT. CARMEL / LOWER GALILEE

~ After a large Israeli breakfast buffet, we visit ancient **Caesarea Maritima** (the **Roman Capital of Israel** for over 500 years). This was the city of **Peter's "Gentile Pentecost"** and **Paul's** imprisonment. We sit in the same amphitheater where **Paul** was tried, then stroll through **Caesarea's** amazing Roman ruins. We visit **Herod the Great's** palace (later **Pilate's** palace) beside the Roman hippodrome on the **Mediterranean Sea**.

~ We drive to the "horn" of **Mt. Carmel** to visit **Muhraka**, where **Elijah** had his contest with **Jezebel's** Baal prophets. From **Mt. Carmel**, we can view the **Valley of Jezreel** and **Kishon**, where **Elijah** slew 400 of **Jezebel's** Baal prophets. When Israel's drought was broken **Ahab** raced his chariot to his summer palace at **Jezreel**.

~ Driving to ancient **Megiddo**, we recall the 21 battles (in the **Hebrew Scriptures**) that were fought in this valley. The view is an unforgettable panorama of prophecy, as the **Armageddon** battlefield of **Revelation** spreads out before us. We view the **Canaanite** ruins, their cultic altar (for human sacrifice), the chariot stables of **Solomon** and **Ahab**.

~ Crossing the Valley of Jezreel/Armageddon, we pass Mt. Tabor to the East. Here King Saul visited the witch of En Dor by night and learned of his fate the next day. On the eastern slope of Mt. Moreh, Jesus raised the widow's son to life at Nain. And on the western slope of Mt. Moreh, Elisha raised a widow's son. On the western side of the valley stands Mt. Gilboa, where Saul and Jonathan were killed by the Philistines.

~ Traversing the **Valley of Jezreel** our bus climbs the hills of **Lower Galilee** to **Nazareth**. We will visit Nazareth Village. This replica of a **Nazareth** farming community or rural village has been reconstructed to resemble the area when **Jesus** grew up in the first century. Here in the synagogue, we will recall **Jesus**' childhood and early manhood.

~ Directly North of Nazareth lies the well-watered Netofa Valley. Above that valley is Cana, (the *Place of Reeds*) where, we believe, *Jesus* changed the water to wine.

We will bus through the traditional Crusader Kefar Cana on the Pilgrim's Highway.

~ Descending to the **Sea of Galilee** (686' below sea level) we proceed to our seaside **Ron Beach Hotel**, "our home" on the **Sea of Galilee**. The Sabbath begins at sundown. Enjoy the incredible view and the best hotel food in all Israel.

No other place on earth offers a better opportunity to "Walk where Jesus Walked".

Day 4 - Feb 24 - Saturday (Shabbat)

SABBATH WORSHIP ON SEA OF GALILEE – Walk in the Footsteps of Jesus

~ We begin our Shabbat at **Nof Ginnosar** to view the *"Jesus Boat"*. Then, we embark by boat for a unique **Shabbat Worship Service** on the **Sea of Galilee**. From the Sea we will recall the *"Sightings of Jesus"*; including the sudden storms, Jesus' miracles, His Disciple's fishing experiences, His teachings by the Sea and His ministry at the **Sea of Galilee** and the **Cove of the Parables**.

~ Debarking at Capernaum Park, then it is "boots on the ground" as we proceed to the Catholic excavations of Capernaum.

~ Capernaum was the headquarters of Jesus' Ministry for 2½ years in Galilee, where we believe Jesus was the Teaching Rabbi of the synagogue. Here He called Levi/ Matthew, taught many parables, performed miracles, raised Jairus' daughter to life, and taught on "The Bread of Life" in the synagogue. In Jesus' Capernaum Synagogue we will worship and recall the events of His ministry. Wow!

~ The Cove of the Parables and Natural Amphitheater (Sower's Cove) is our host's favorite highlight of our tour. Here Jesus called His Disciples, borrowed Peter's boat for His teaching, taught many parables and healed the multitudes.

~ At the Cove we will consider the **NT** "Jesus Sightings". While seated on the lush green grass and basalt rocks, our tour host, Bob Ross, will lead in a study of these events. His focus the last several years has plumbed the depths of Jesus' ministry here at His favorite area.

~ On this seashore our Resurrected Lord appeared to His Disciples, provided the miraculous catch, and prepared breakfast for them. He forgave **Peter** and instructed him to "Feed His Sheep".

~ Following the *Jesus' Trail*, along the beautiful shoreline, we hike to **Tabgha**, (the largest spring feeding the **Sea of Galilee**) and there visit the ancient **Leper's Pool** nearby.

~ Climbing to Wilderness Cave we will see the likely place where our Lord prayed all night before calling His Apostles.

~ Then, on the lower slope of the Mount of Beatitudes we will share *Jesus' Beatitudes* (at the place where He shared them 2,000 years ago). This is a great place to consider Jesus' Word Pictures from His "Sermon on the Mount".

~ Afterwards, we will stroll to **Tabgha** to visit the Byzantine mosaic of the *Loaves and the Fishes* and discuss **Peter's Primacy** at the beautiful traditional Catholic location.

~ After a marvelous lunch of *St. Peter's Fish*, we follow the old *Roman Road* which skirts the North Shore. Crossing the Jordan River, Bethsaida is pointed out as the seaside home of *Peter, Andrew, James* and *John*, and *Zebedee's* fishing company. (Mendel Nun, the authority on first century Sea of Galilee ports and water levels, believed that in Jesus' day the fishing village of Bethsaida was located where the Jordan River entered the Sea of Galilee. He believed that the fishing village was part of Bethsaida Julius. Jesus healed the blind man from Bethsaida.

~ Diving South we enter the **Gentile Decapolis** (on the Eastern shore). We will recall **Jesus**' healing the demoniac near **Kursi**, and visit the cliff where Jesus drove the demons into the swine. The pigs rushed over the cliff and were drowned in the Sea. Deviled ham did a "swan dive".

~ Along this Eastern shore, rising above the Sea, is the incredible ruins of **Susita/Hippos**. To this Gentile city **Jesus** sent the healed demoniac as His witness. Later, there were 7 churches and 1 cathedral in this once pagan city. In Jesus' day, the stone pagan temples glistened in the afternoon sun casting their reflection over the Sea. We propose that this was the city **Jesus** pointed to and said, "a city set on a hill cannot be hidden..."

~ Returning to the southern end of the Sea of Galilee, we Baptize (those who desire) in the Jordan River, at beautiful Yardenit.

~ After our evening meal, you may want to close the Shabbat by strolling the quaint streets of Tiberias and enjoy dessert and coffee. Or...

sit with friends by the water's edge and enjoy the beauty of the evening and the stars over the Sea of Galilee.

- 2nd Overnight Ron Beach on the Sea of Galilee. -

Day 5 – Feb 25 – Sunday

HULEH BASIN / DAN / CEASAREA PHILIPPI / MT. HERMON / GOLAN HEIGHTS

~ Departing the Sea of Galilee, our bus takes us to Upper Galilee for a scenic drive overviewing the Huleh Basin. Passing ancient Hazor and proceed to the beautiful Dan Nature Preserve. The lush and beautiful Headwaters of the Jordan leave an indelible impression.

~ The excavations at ancient Dan include the altar where the golden calf was worshiped by Israel under Jeroboam.

~ After viewing the Israel/Lebanon border, we stroll to the new excavation of the Canaanite Gate from Abraham's time. Then, visit the city gate of OT Dan, the "Hill of the Judge" to see the ancient city and the amazing "Cyclop walls".

~ We drive to **Caesarea Philippi**, where *Jesus* brought his **Disciples** on retreat. This was the **Roman** pagan cultic center, featuring pagan temples and the *"gates of hell"*. *Jesus* asked His **Disciples**, *"Who do YOU say that I AM?"* **Peter** answered, *"You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God"*. One week later, *Jesus* was transfigured on **Mt. Hermon**.

~ While viewing the Jordan Valley from the Golan Heights. Yehuda will explain the Arab/Israel War of 1967 and the conflict for this area.

~ Traveling the Mt. Hermon foothills, on a section of the Damascus Road, we recall Saul's conversion near Damascus.

~ We drive past Druze Villages, as the snow-capped "granddaddy" of the mountains in Israel, Mount Hermon, towers above. What majesty!

~ We will enjoy an incredible Arab lunch at a Druze restaurant.

~ After lunch, in the "Valley of Death", Yehuda will discuss the conflict of 1973. In all her wars, God has led Israel to incredible victories.

~ Descending through the **Golan** tableland, you will come to understand the agricultural and strategic military importance of the Golan Heights to Israel. The **Golan** must remain in Israel's hands! As time allows, we hope to visit the **Jordan River** in this area of **Jesus'** ministry.

- We return for another overnight at our Ron Beach Hotel (3rd night) at the Sea of Galilee. -

Day 6 – Feb 26 – Monday

GAMALA / KATZRIN / KORAZIN / MOUNT of BEATITUDES / MAGDALA

~ Gamala is visited by few tourists. Usually, the lack of tour time (half a day) and physical strength of the group prevents tours from climbing the difficult path to the top of the abandoned city. However, we hope to make special arrangements, if the road is open, to bus to the site.

~ This unique first century Jewish ruin is often called "The Masada of Galilee". An estimated 10,000 Jews died in the Roman conquest of Galilee.

(Gamala and Masada are two of the highlights on our tour). At Gamala, we hope to visit the synagogue (where we believe Jesus taught), see where the Romans broke through the wall and visit the famous round tower the Roman's attacked.

~ We then drive to the capital of the Golan for a visit to Katzrin's reconstructed NT Village to discover Jewish life as it was in Jesus' day.

~ After an early lunch at the popular **Blueberry Restaurant**, we view the descriptive and fascinating museum film on **The Fall of Gamala**.

~ Bussing to the top eastern side of the Mt. of Beatitudes, we visit the third synagogue where Jesus served as the Teaching Rabbi. Here at Korazin we view the mikvah, the yeshiva, the synagogue of Jesus' day, and see the Seat of Moses where Jesus unrolled the scroll before reading the prescribed Shabbat Scripture of the week.

~ Traveling again through the Valley of Ginnosar, we come to NT Magdala. Jesus first came to the Sea of Galilee and cast 7 demons out of Mary Magdalene. Our architect friend, Matti Avshalomon, designed the quaint and beautiful Reflection Church near the shore. We will visit the recently discovered synagogue, yeshiva, and stroll through the beautiful Reflection Church. Josephus wrote his Jewish Wars at Migdal.

- Our 4th and last night at the Sea of Galilee - Evening meal and overnight at Ron Beach -This is our last opportunity to enjoy dialogue and coffee in the moonlight at our hotel. Most Christians leave "a part of their heart" at the Sea of Galilee. Enjoy this last evening in Galilee.

Day 7 – Feb 27 – Tuesday BEIT SHEAN / GIDEON'S SPRING / JORDAN VALLEY WILDERNESS OF JUDEA / JERICHO / DEAD SEA QUMRAN

~ Departing the **Sea of Galilee**, we drive south through the **Jordan River Valley** to the incredible **OT** and **Roman** ruin of **Beit Shean**. This **Decapolis** city was the only Greek city of the ten west of the **Jordan River**. The excavations reveal a first century Roman city with temples, baths, a theater, and hippodrome. Strolling the streets, you will learn of the **Roman Empire**, and see the beauty of this pagan (Decapolis) city of **Jesus'** day. The **OT** tel of **Beit Shean** rises above the **Jordan Valley**. **Saul** and **Jonathan's** bodies were hung on the city gate.

~ We will visit **Gideon's Spring**, where God selected **Gideon's** 300-man army. This spring is one of the ten most beautiful "swimming holes" in the world. We will enjoy the park, but a swim may be a bit chilly. Your choice.

~ We bus south through the Jordan River Valley. The Jordan River and the country of Jordan lie to the East, and the Mountains of Samaria to the West. The hour-and-a-half drive takes us in and out of the "West Bank" territory. (See the Discover Israel map on page 169.)

~ Depending on the changing political climate, we may have lunch in **Jericho**. The city spreads out around **Elijah's Spring**, at the foot of **Tel e-Sultan** (dating to the Stone Age). **Jericho** is the oldest continuously inhabited city in the world, inhabited since approximately 10,000 BC.

~ A **Neolithic** tower, the world's oldest building, dates to 7,000 BC. At **Jericho** "The walls came tumbling down" (the result of **God's** judgement). It was **Israel's** first conquest in "**God's Land**". Unfortunately, the city is today in the hands of the PLO. Above **Jericho** rises the **Mt. of Temptation**, the traditional site of **Jesus'** temptations in the **Wilderness of Judea**. We bus the descent to the **Dead Sea**.

~ John the Baptist often ministered in this area, slightly North of where the Jordan enters the Dead Sea. In this area Our Lord was baptized.

~ The **Dead Sea** is 1,300 feet below sea level and is the lowest place on earth. The rainfall here is less than 4" per year. The surrounding area is "a *dry and thirsty land*". The mountains of the **Wilderness of Judea** tower above the Sea on the West.

~ We view the area of ancient **Gilgal**, located just north of the **Dead Sea. Gilgal** was the largest of all Jewish cities (until today). Here, the **Twelve Tribes** of Israel first dwelt when they entered the Land of Canaan. At Gilgal the men of Israel were circumcised, the manna ceased, and Israel sacrificed to God. **Gilgal** lies just south of Jericho, the first city Israel conquered. Between **Gilgal** and Jericho, Joshua met "the angel of the Lord", who took over leadership and led Israel to conquer the "Land of Canaan".

~ Driving along the west side of the **Dead Sea**, we will point out the cave where archaeologist **Vendyl Jones** searched for the **"Ashes of the Red Heifer"** and the Temple Treasures at **Wadi ha Kippah**. The fictitious movie, **Indiana Jones**, was based on Vendyl's experiences, with the usual embellishments by Hollywood. You will hear the details on our tour. Most interesting!

~ We visit the extensive ruins of **Qumran**, where the *Dead Sea Scrolls* were found. For years, it was felt that the inhabitants were the *Essenes*, and that they recorded the scrolls. However, our guide will tell the story of *the Sect of the Wilderness of Judea*, who recorded and hid the scrolls from the invading Romans. Because of their beliefs, today many see the sect as a "*pre-Christian*" community. *John the Baptist* and our Lord held many of the same beliefs as this *Sect* (that is; a pierced Messiah with pre-mortal existence, a new covenant, sabbath observance, the last days, judgment, resurrection, angels, and the afterlife). They spent their days committed to reading, studying, and writing the Scriptures. We believe that *John the Baptist* was perhaps raised and educated through yeshiva (seminary) by the Qumran community.

~ *Muhammed adh-Dhib*, a Bedouin man, discovered the first of the *Dead Sea Scrolls* while caring for his sheep. He sold them to an antiquities dealer in **Bethlehem** by the name of *Kando*. The Syrian archbishop of Jerusalem obtained 4, and *Dr. Eleazar Sukenik* of the **Hebrew University** purchased 3 of the scrolls on Nov. 29, 1947 (the <u>very day</u> that the *United Nations* voted for the re-creation of the Jewish state, Israel, after 2,000 years). You must hear **Yehuda's** miraculous story about the scrolls. Then, we proceed to our hotel on the **Dead Sea**.

Judea. Relax and enjoy the spa, a massage, and float in the Dead Sea. – Overnight David Spa Hotel, Ein Bokek (2 nights). –

Day 8 – Feb 28 – Wednesday

WILDERNESS OF JUDEA / MASADA / EIN GIDI / DEAD SEA / PALESTINA LIMITUS

Our "Bravest Warriors" can hike to the top of Mt. Masada (discuss arrangements please, it is not an easy hike). All others who have "Good Common Sense", will take the cable car to the top about 8:00am.

~ Masada is one of the most important mountains in world history. You will hear the incredible story of the Jewish Freedom Fighters who held out against the Romans in 73 AD. The story of the struggle, the excavations, and the view from the top over the Judean Wilderness and Dead Sea will long burn in your memory as a *highlight* of the tour. From the top of Masada, one can see Jordan, Edom, the Arabah Valley, and the Negev.

~ Departing Masada, we travel north to Ein Gedi/Spring of the Wild Goats. Then we hike to the waterfalls and recall David hiding from King Saul in the mountain cave behind the veil of the waterfalls. Ein Gedi is known for her beautiful cascading streams and refreshing pools. David spared King Saul's life here. Incredible story.

~ Following lunch, we travel south along the **Dead Sea** to view the modern Israeli chemical operations at this incredible Sea. En route, we will discuss the destruction of **Sodom** and **Gomorrah**. According to the *Hebrew Scriptures God* literally *turned the earth upside down*. Nothing is left of the two cities today.

~ Just south of the **Dead Sea** is the overlook the **Arabah Valley** and the farthest outpost of the **Roman Empire**, **Palestina Limitus**. The great Roman Empire extended from here to **Cold Water**, **Scotland** (a five-hour flight today).

- Returning to our hotel, David's Spa, in Ein Boqek, we relax and prepare our minds and hearts for the Holy City of Jerusalem. -

Day 9 – Feb 29 – Thursday WILDERNESS OF JUDEA / NEGEV / ARAD / BEERSHEVA / VALLEY OF ELAH THE HOLY CITY OF JERUSALEM

~ Departing the Dead Sea hotel, we bus through the northern **Negev of Israel**. The difference in the topography of *God's Land* will amaze you. This desert area of Israel presents a majesty of its own.

~ We will visit **Tel Arad** (5,000 years old), and see a sanctuary built according to the layout of the **Holy of Holies** (instructed by God) in **Solomon's Temple**. How did the ancients know? **King Solomon** had a fortress near here.

~ Journeying West we come to the *Capital of the Negev*, Beersheba (meaning "*Well of the seven*"). At Tel es Seba Abraham dug 7 wells before he entered a covenant with the Abimelech. Abraham lived here, the angel spoke to *Hagar, Jacob* fled from *Esau, Jacob* offered sacrifices to God, and the angels fed *Elijah*. The OT proverbial expression "from Dan to Beersheva" described the size of Israel in *David's* day. A stone highway connected the two. ~ We will visit ancient underground Beersheva (6,000 years old) and see "Abraham's Well". The whole ancient city is a marvel indeed.

~ After lunch, we travel north through ancient Judea and Philistia to visit the Valley of Elah, where David slew Goliath. Don't miss Yehuda's story of the event.

~ Next. we view the Valley of Sorek from Tel Beit-Shemesh ("Temple of the Sun"). The inhabitants of this Israelite city received the returning Ark of the Covenant from its captivity in Philistia. The Sorek Valley was the site of Sampson's early exploits and were he dated Delilah.

~ Our bus climbs from the **Shephelah** (low foothills) into the **Judean Mountains** toward the **Holy City of Jerusalem**. The pilgrims of the **OT** sang the songs *of Ascent*" (Psalm 120-134) as they ascended the highways leading to **God's Holy City**, for the annual Feasts.

- Jerusalem Cassia Hotel (Night 1) -

Concerning our tour in Jerusalem...

Our guide, Yehuda Hecht, and his ancestors have lived in Jerusalem since the Twelfth Century AD. He has carefully planned our itinerary choosing the best days and times to experience his "hometown". Every site possible will be seen, but not necessarily in the order on our itinerary. We leave Jerusalem in his capable hands. Yehuda will coordinate our site visits with Shabbat, and any Jewish holidays, even working around parades or marathons. Though our itinerary may change in Jerusalem, Yehuda will seek to cover every site listed, and more, much more. Thanks Yehuda!

Day 10 – March 1 – Friday Morning The Holy City of Jerusalem MOUNT OF OLIVES / GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE / KIDRON VALLEY / CAIAPHAS' HOUSE WAILING WALL / SOUTHERN EXCAVATIONS

~ Our day begins on top of the **Mount of Olives.** From here we have an incredible panoramic view of the **Temple Mount**, the **Dome of the Rock**, the **Golden Gate**, the ancient **Walls of Jerusalem**, and the **Kidron Valley**. Our guide will share a marvelous presentation of the Biblical and historical events related to **Jerusalem**. His **Historical Overview** will cover pre-Biblical **Jerusalem**, through the **Hebrew Scriptures** and **New Testament** events, up to present day **Israel**.

~ We walk down the traditional path of *Jesus' Triumphal Entry*, to the edge of the Kidron Valley. Here we visit the beautiful Garden of Gethsemane. Our devotional time here will recall Jesus' experiences related to the *Passover* and *Gethsemane*.

~ From the Garden we enter the Kidron Valley, past the Tomb of the Kings, and then climb up Mt. Ophel to the Temple walls.

~ We visit the House of Caiaphas/ St. Peter in Galicantu, the place of Jesus' early interrogation and/or "Jewish trials". In the courtyard Peter denied our Lord three times. Here, we teach that Jesus was kept in the Prison Pit, Tortured, and "Flayed" or "Caned" by the Jewish authorities. You will learn of the details of Jesus' suffering for us. After viewing the first century Roman street Jesus used, we will overlook the "Field of Blood" where Judas hanged himself. At this location, you are standing just above the confluence of the Kidron, Cheesemaker and Hinnon Valley at New Testament - Gehenna (the Place of Burning).

~ After lunch, we will take quality time at the Wailing/Western Wall and worship with Jews prior to their Sabbath.

~ We visit the Southern Excavations, and the southern Temple Entrance in Jesus' day.

AFTERNOON – DAY 10

MT OPHEL / KING DAVID'S CITY / HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL / POOL OF SILOAM / JEWISH QUARTER

~ At King David's City on Mt. Ophel, we will visit the incredible Canaanite ruins, the Jebusite water system, David's Tomb, Joab's Tunnel, and exit at the recent excavations of the Pool of Siloam, connecting to Hezekiah's Tunnel.

Note: Arrangements can be made to walk thru **Hezekiah's Tunnel** and meet our group at the **Pool of Siloam.** The tunnel is about knee-deep in water. Digging from both ends, the workers met in the middle, beneath **Mt. Opel.** The tunnel is an unforgettable 45-minute wet hike. Wear old water shoes or tennis shoes. Bring a flashlight or elastic cap light. The water is comfortable, and most of the base is plastered and quite even for our tunnel adventure. Don't plan on this hike if you are claustrophobic.

~ If time allows, we will visit the Jewish Quarter of Jerusalem to consider her history and view Nehemiah's Wall.

The Sabbath begins at sundown. Enjoy the special Shabbat meal and celebrate the "Joys of the Shabbat" in Jerusalem. – Jerusalem Cassia Hotel (2nd night). –

Day 11 – March 2 – Saturday (Jerusalem on Shabbat) JERUSLAEM'S OLD CITY / TRIALS OF JESUS / VIA DOLOROSA / CHURCH OF HOLY SEPULCHER

~ Our day begins at the Lion's Gate, to focus on the importance of Israel's return to the Holy City in June of 1967, "The end of the Age of the Gentiles". Our guide, Yehuda, led Israel's reconnaissance unit, Rabbi Shlomo Goren, and the Israeli troops through this gate on June 7th, 1967 (Six Day War). What an incredible story!

~ We proceed to the **Pool of Bethesda**, where *Jesus* healed the lame man. Here we visit the **Crusader Church** of **St. Anne** and experience the incredible acoustics of the chapel. Who will sing for us?

~ Nearby is the **Tower of Antonia**, **Praetorium** and **Pilate's Judgment Hall**. Our **Lord Jesus** was tried here before **Pontus Pilate**, beaten by the **Roman Cohort**, received the **Crown of Thorns** and took up **His Cross**. Here we view the **King's Game**, inscribed on the **Pavement** stones near **Pilate's Judgment Seat.** The **Ecce Homo Arch** is where **Pilate** told the Jews "Behold, the man".

~ The Ecce Homo begins the Traditional Via Dolorosa, with the 13 "Stations of the Cross" (determined by the Crusaders, not very Biblical). We will visit the Praetorium Prison, where we believe Jesus was imprisoned, and where Peter was likely imprisoned and released by God's angel. The Crusader Via Dolorosa route leads to the 4th century Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the traditional Catholic/Orthodox site of Jesus' Death, Burial, and Resurrection.

~ After lunch, in the Old City of Jerusalem, there will be a brief time for shopping.

Calvary and the Garden Tomb Experience...

~ We pass through the **Damascus Gate**, en route to **Calvary** and the **Garden Tomb**. We believe this is the most reliable site for *Jesus' Crucifixion* (*The Hill of the Skull*), *His Burial*, and *Resurrection* (the **Garden Tomb**). After visiting the **Empty Tomb**, we will discuss the *events in Jesus'* **Death** *and* **Resurrection**, in detail. **Celebration of the Lord's Supper** will close our worship time.

~ We will have time for personal prayer time in the Garden and allow time to shop in the Garden Tomb Book Store.

- We return to our Cassia Hotel (3rd night). -

Day 12 – March 3 – Sunday

TEMPLE MOUNT / HERODIUM / BETHLEHEM / SHEPHERD'S FIELDS

~ We begin our day on the **Temple Mount**, with a lecture about the **Temple's** historical background. You will view the Muslim **Mosque of El Aksa** over the **Dome of the Rock**. We will visit the **Dome of the Spirits**, where we believe the **Holy of Holies** stood on **Mt. Moriah/Mt. Zion**. This was the location of **Solomon's**, **Zerubbabel's**, and **Herod's Temples**. Here **Abraham** prepared to sacrifice **Isaac**. The mount became the place for sacrifices for Israel in the Hebrew Scriptures. At the north end of this **Mountain of Sacrifice - Our Lord** laid down His life.

~ Departing Jerusalem, we drive to the Herodium, the mountain that Herod the Great moved to build his palace. Jesus referred to the "kings in their palaces," and Herod had two palaces in this location. The Herodium was the place of his elaborate funeral. (His tomb was only recently discovered.) From the Herodium you have an incredible view of Bethlehem, the Wilderness of Judea, and the Negev.

~ Crossing into the **"West Bank"** at the *Israeli/Palestinian* Checkpoint, we proceed to **Bethlehem**. We will briefly visit **Bethlehem Square** and the traditional place of *Jesus'* birth, the Church of the Nativity (built by Constantine's mother, *Queen Helena*- the second oldest in world).

~ At "Shepherd's Field", we discuss Joseph and Mary's visit to Bethlehem, and Jesus' Birth.

~ Then, we enjoy an incredible Arab meal at *The Tent*. Wow! You won't forget this meal or atmosphere.

~ After lunch, we visit an **Olive Wood Factory and Shop.** You may want to select items or gifts from the world's most beautiful *olive wood* carvings. You will learn of the **Plight of the Christians**, who live under **Bethlehem's** Muslim administration.

- We return to Cassia Hotel (4th night). -

After our evening meal at the hotel, we will gather for a "share time" together. Be prepared with a "love gift" and a word of "Thanks" for our guide and driver at this time. Please attend.

Day 13 – March 4 – Monday

NEW JERUSALEM / YAD VASHIM / ISRAEL MUSEUM / MODEL of FIRST CENTURY JERUSALEM

~ In the New City of Jerusalem, our morning is spent in Yad Vashem, Israeli's Holocaust Museum.

Warning: You will not come out of this museum the same person as when you entered.

~ Next, we visit the amazing Model of Century Jerusalem and the Israel Museum.

~ While at the Museum, we visit the Shrine of the Book (Dead Sea Scrolls).

The balance of the day is in the hands of our Guide, Yehuda to "wrap" up his hometown of Jerusalem.

Our schedule is at his discretion. This is always fun.

- We return to the Cassia Hotel (5th Night) to pack for tomorrow's return. -

After the evening meal, go to bed as early as possible. Get rest for your return flight

Day 14: March 5 – Tuesday "SHALOM ISRAEL!"

- ~ Since flights vary, times of departures and transportation to the airport will also vary. We will assist you on airport transportation.
- ~ Thank you for being with us. It has been an incredible joy to have you.
- ~ Your Israel Study Tour has been intense. Try to rest on your return flight. It is the most difficult part of the tour. Expect jet lag when you return.

MAR 5th | Cross from Israel into Jordan at Allenby Bridge. Proceed to Mt. Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land. At Madeba see the world's oldest mosaic map. Travel to Machaerus, Herod's incredible palace, where John the Baptist was in prison. We bus thru Moab and Edom to our Petra Hotel.

MAR 6th | Enjoy a 5 hour visit to ancient **Petra**, the ancient Nabatean capital and a *"Wonder of the World"*. Bussing to **Amman**, the capital of **Jordan**, we will visit her Roman ruins and spend a memorable night.
