Travel Day - Wed. Feb 18 (Travel) ~ Arrival Day - Thurs. Feb 19

You must arrange for your flights to and from Israel. Please arrange to arrive the afternoon of the 19th. We will gather at the *Leonardo Hotel* in Netanya for our evening meal the 19th. Following the meal, we will have our first group meeting, and you will receive your personal audio receiver for the tour. **Note:** Please send us your flight information, including your arrival time in Israel. If you arrive after the bus goes to Netanya, we will try to help you arrange for a van to the hotel. If not, please plan to take a taxi to our hotel.

~ En route to the hotel, you will skirt **Tel Aviv**, the "beautiful new 100-year-old city". One could spend weeks visiting the museums of this incredible Jewish city, but our tour is a Biblical one. We overnight at the **Leonardo Hotel, Netanya**, by the **Mediterranean Sea.**

Tour Day 1 – Feb 20 – Friday

MEDITERRANEAN COAST / MT. CARMEL / LOWER GALILEE
In This brochure we will simply list the sites and area we will visit. No details. Refer to
your copy of *Discover Israel* (check index) for the site details and Scriptures.

- ~Visit Ancient Caesarea Maritima (Roman Capital of Israel for 500 years).on the Mediterranean.
- ~ Mt. Carmel Muhrak (Elijah's contest with Jezebel's Baal prophets) Valley of Jezreel.
- ~Lunch at Megiddo cafeteria.
- ~Visit ancient **Megiddo** and **Armageddon** (21 battles in the **Hebrew Scriptures** that were fought in this valley. Savor the unforgettable panorama of the **Armageddon** battlefield of **Revelation**.
- ~ Crossing the Valley of Jezreel/Armageddon, we view Mt. Tabor, Mt. Moreh and Mt. Gilboa.
- ~ Our bus climbs to Lower Galilee Nazareth and Nazareth Village (a farming community of Jesus' day).
- ~We pass through traditional Crusader Kefar Cana on the Pilgrim's Highway.

Descending to the Sea of Galilee (686' below sea level) to our seaside Ron Beach Hotel, ("our home" on the Sea of Galilee). The Sabbath begins at sundown. Enjoy the incredible Galilee view and the best hotel food in all Israel.

No other place on earth offers a better opportunity to "Walk where Jesus Walked".

Tour Day 2 – Feb 21 – Saturday (Shabbat)

JESUS BOAT/SHABBAT WORSHIP ON THE SEA/GALILEE OF THE GENTILES CAPERNAUM/COVE OF THE PARABLES/MT. OF BEATITUDES

WILDERNESS CAVE/TABGHA/MIGDAL

- ~We begin our day at **Nof Ginnosar Museum** to see the famous "Jesus Boat"
- ~Embark by Boat on the **Sea of Galilee** for our "**Shabbat Travel Sermon**" on the **Sea**. We recall the "**Jesus Sightings**" (quieting the storms, His parables, miracles, His teachings and healing).
- ~Bethsaida excavations at the Jordan River (home of Peter, Andrew, James and John)
- ~ We bus to the Gentile Decapolis, past Kursi to the "casting out of demons into the swine".
- ~East of us is Hippos/Susita, the "City set on a Hill". To be discussed.
- ~(Lunch of St. Peter's fish).
- ~Returning to the **North Shore**, we visit **Capernaum** (Jesus was the "Teaching Rabbi" His headquarters for 2½ years of His ministry. Here He called **Levi/ Matthew**, taught parables, performed miracles, raised **Jairus**' daughter to life, taught on "*The Bread of Life*". In **Jesus' Capernaum Synagogue** we will worship and recall His ministry. **Wow!**
- ~The Cove of the Parables and Natural Amphitheater (likely the highlight of our tour). Here Jesus called His Disciples, borrowed Peter's boat for His teaching, taught many parables and healed the multitudes.

At the **Cove of the Parables**, while seated on the lush green grass and basalt rocks, Bro. Bob will lead our study on "Jesus Sightings" as we plumb the depths of Jesus' ministry in Galilee. Here our Resurrected Lord appeared to His Disciples.

- ~ Then, walking the *Jesus' Trail*, along the beautiful shoreline, we hike to **Tabgha**, to see **Lepere's Pool**, the mosaic of the **Loaves and Fishes** and visit traditional **Peter's Primacy**.
- ~ Climbing to Wilderness Cave where Jesus prayed all night before calling His Apostles.
- ~ On the lower slope of the **Mount of Beatitudes** we will share **Jesus' Beat I t u d e s** (where He shared.) A great place to consider **Jesus' Word Pictures** from His "**Sermon on the Mount**".

What a Day in Jesus' Footsteps!

After our evening meal, you may close the Shabbat by strolling the quaint streets of Tiberias and enjoy dessert and coffee. Or...Sit with friends by the water's edge and enjoy the beauty of the evening and the stars over the Sea of Galilee.

2nd Night at Ron Beach on the Sea of Galilee.

Tour Day 3– Feb 22– Sunday

HULEH BASIN / DAN / CEASAREA PHILIPPI / MT. HERMON / GOLAN HEIGHTS

- ~Traveling north, we bus to **Upper Galilee** with a scenic drive overviewing the **Huleh Basin**. We pass ancient **Hazor** and proceed to the beautiful **Dan Nature Preserve** and the **Headwaters of the Jordan**.
- ~Strolling the Jordan we visit ancient Dan (the altar of the golden calf, worshiped by Israel).
- ~ We view the Israel/Lebanon border and the Canaanite Gate from Abraham's time enroute to Dan's amazing walls and city gate.
- ~Then, to Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus brought his Disciples. A Roman pagan cultic with the "gates of hell". Here Jesus asked, "Who do You say I Am?" Peter responded, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God".
- ~A week later, Jesus was Transfigured on Mt. Hermon.
- **~ We view the Jordan Valley from the Golan Heights.** (Our guide will explain the Arab/Israel War of 1967 and the conflict for this area.
- ~Traveling the Mt. Hermon foothills, on the Damascus Road, we will recall Saul's conversion.
- ~ We drive past **Druze Villages**, as the snow-capped "granddaddy" of the mountains, **Mount**Hermon, towers above with majesty!
- ~ Incredible "Arab lunch" Druze restaurant.
- ~ After lunch, in the "Valley of Death", Yehuda will discuss the Yom Kippur War '73.

~Descending through the Golan Heights tableland, we cross the Jordan River, headed "home".

Great evening meal and 3rd overnight at Ron Beach on the Sea of Galilee.

Tour Day 4 – Feb 23 – Monday GAMALA / KATZRIN / KORAZIN / MOUNT of BEATITUDES / MAGDALA

- **~Gamala** is visited by few tourists. Our tour group does not have the time or energy to climb the mountain. So, we hope to make special arrangements, if the lower road is open, to bus to the base of Gamala.
- ~ This unique first century Jewish ruin is called "The Masada of Galilee". An estimated 10,000 Jews died rather than become slaves to Rome. Most leaped to their deaths.
- ~Katzrim (1st Century Jewish village and synagogue...as in Jesus' day)
- ~Lunch at the Blueberry Restaurant in Katzrim
- ~View presentation of "Fall of Gamala" at Katrim Museum
- ~Return to Galilee to visit Korazin (atop Mt. of Beatitudes Jesus was the "Teaching Rabbi".
- ~Close our day at Magdala (Home of Mary Magdalene) visit synagogue, yeshiva and "Reflection Church".

4th Night at Ron Beach...Savor the Evening!

Tour Day 5 – Feb 24 – Tuesday

To this Tour we have added one extra day in the Galilee. Possibly Adding...
SEPPHORIS/CANA/MT. MOREH-NAIN/MT. GERAZIM/ JEZREEL/
GIDEON'S SPRINGS/YARDENIT BAPTISMS

- ~Visit **Sepphoris** (where Jesus attended Yeshiva/Seminary
- ~Overlook **Netofa Valley** and **Cana** (Jesus first miracle...water to wine)
- ~Valley of Jezreel to Nain on Mt Moreh (Jesus raised widow's son)
- ~Mt. Gerazim (death of Saul and Jonathan)
- ~Jezreel (home of Ahab and Jezebel
- ~Lunch at Harod Springs
- ~Yehudah's lecture at **Gideon's Springs**...You can Swim, the water is beautiful but chilly.
- ~To **Jordan River-Yardenit** to Baptize those who desire to be Baptized in the Jordan.

Most Christians leave "a part of their heart" at the Sea of Galilee. Enjoy this last evening in Galilee...5th Night at Ron Beach.

Tour Day 6 – Feb 25 – Wednesday BEIT SHEAN / JORDAN VALLEY/ WILDERNESS OF JUDEA / OUMRAN/ DEAD SEA

- ~ Departing the Sea of Galilee, we drive south through the Jordan River Valley to...
- ~Beit Shean. This Decapolis city was the only Greek city of the ten west of the Jordan River. The OT Tel of Beit Shean rises above the Jordan Valley. Saul and Jonathan's bodies were hung on the city gate. It was destroyed by an earthquake in the Roman period and never rebuilt.
- ~We bus south through the **Jordan River Valley**. The **Jordan River** and the country of **Jordan** lie to the East, and the **Mountains of Samaria** to the West. The hour-and-a-half drive takes us in and out of the "**West Bank**" territory. (See the **Discover Israel** map on page 169.)
- ~Due to the political situation, we will bypass ancient **Jericho**. Above **Jericho** rises the **Mt**. **of Temptation**, the traditional site of **Jesus**' temptations in the **Wilderness of Judea**.
- ~We bus the descent to the **Dead Sea**. **John the Baptist** often ministered in this area, slightly North of where the **Jordan** enters the **Dead Sea**. In this area **Our Lord was baptized**. We will visit the traditional site.

- ~ The **Dead Sea** is 1,300 feet below sea level and is the lowest place on earth. The surrounding area is "a *dry and thirsty land*". The mountains of the **Wilderness of Judea** tower above the Sea on the West.
- ~ We view the area of ancient Gilgal, located just north of the Dead Sea.
- ~ Gilgal was the largest of all Jewish cities (until today). Here, the Twelve Tribes of Israel first dwelt when they entered the Land of Canaan. Gilgal lies just south of Jericho, the first city Israel conquered. Between Gilgal and Jericho, Joshua met "the angel of the Lord", who took over leadership and led Israel to conquer the "Land of Canaan".

~Lunch at Qumran Cafeteria

- ~Driving along the west side of the **Dead Sea**, we drive past **Wadi ha Kippah** and the cave where archaeologist **Vendyl Jones** searched for the **"Ashes of the Red Heifer"** and the Temple Treasures. The fictitious movie, **Indiana Jones**, was based on Vendel's experiences,
- ~We walk thru the extensive ruins of **Qumran**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were found. Today many see the sect as a "pre-Christian" community. **John the Baptist** and our Lord held many of the same beliefs as this "**Sect of the Wilderness of Judea**" (a pierced Messiah with pre-mortal existence, a new covenant, sabbath observance, the last days, judgment, resurrection, angels, and afterlife). We believe that **John the Baptist** was raised and educated through yeshiva (seminary) by the **Qumran** community.
- ~We proceed to our hotel on the Dead Sea...

Relax and enjoy the spa, a massage, and/or float in the Dead Sea.

Overnight David Spa Hotel at Ein Bokek (2 nights).

Tour Day 7 - Feb 26 - Thursday

WILDERNESS OF JUDEA / MASADA / EIN GIDI / DEAD SEA / PALESTINA LIMITUS

- ~ Masada is one of the most important mountains in world history. Hear from Yehuda the incredible story of the Jewish Freedom Fighters, who held out against the Romans in 73 AD. The story of the struggle, the excavations, and the view from the top over the Judean Wilderness and Dead Sea will long burn in your memory as a "Highlight of the tour" From the top of Masada, one can view Jordan, Edom, the Arabah Valley, and the Negev.
- ~Departing Masada, we travel to Ein Gedi/ Spring of the Wild Goats. Then, we hike to the waterfalls and recall David hiding from King Saul. Here David spared King Saul's life
- **~Following lunch-** *Guides choice) we travel south along the **Dead Sea** to view the modern Israeli chemical operations. We will discuss the destruction of **Sodom** and **Gomorrah**.
- ~Just south of the **Dead Sea** is the overlook the **Arabah Valley** and the farthest outpost of the **Roman Empire**, **Palestina Limitus**. The great Roman Empire extended from here to **Cold Water**, **Scotland** (a five-hour flight today).

Returning to our hotel, David's Spa in Ein Boqek.
Here we will relax and prepare our minds and hearts for our visit to Jerusalem.

Tour Day 8 – Feb 27 – Friday

WILDERNESS OF JUDEA / NEGEV/ BEERSHEVA GAZA "ENVELOPE" / VALLEY OF ELAH / HOLY CITY OF JERUSALEM

- ~Departing the Dead Sea hotel, we bus the northern **Negev of Israel**. The difference in the topography of this desert in **God's Land** will amaze you with a majesty of its own.
- ~We pass (5,000 years old) Tel Arad.
- ~We come to the *Capital of the Negev*, Beersheba (meaning "*Well of the seven*"). *Abraham* lived here, the angel spoke to *Hagar*, *Jacob* fled from *Esau*, *Jacob* offered sacrifices to God, and the angels fed *Elijah*. We will visit ancient underground Beersheva (6,000 years old) and see "*Abraham's Well*".

~Lunch enroute...Guide's choice.

- ~We safely travel to a kibbutz in the **Gaza Envelope** that was attack by **Hamas**, Oct. 7th, 2023. The events of that day, that led to the **Gaza War** 2023-2025, will be shared.
- ~We travel north through OT **Philistia** to visit the **Valley of Elah**, where **David** slew **Goliath**. Don't miss Yehuda's story of the event.
- ~Next. we view the Valley of Sorek from Tel Beit-Shemesh ("Temple of the Sun"). Here the *Ark of the Covenant* was returned from its captivity in Philistia. The Sorek Valley was the site of *Sampson's* early exploits and were he dated *Delilah*.
- ~Our bus climbs from the **Shephelah** (low foothills) into the **Judean Mountains** toward the **Holy City of Jerusalem**. The pilgrims of the **OT** sang the "Songs *of Ascent*" (Psalm 120-134) as they ascended the highways leading to **God's Holy City**, for the annual Feasts.

We make our way to our Jerusalem "Home" The Newly renovated Mar Cassia Hotel for 5 nights.

Yehuda will coordinate our site visits with Shabbat, Jewish holidays, working around any parades. Demonstrations or traffic jams. He will choose the best entrance times to sites and select the best and guickest routes. Thanks Yehuda!

Welcome to The Holy City of Jerusalem!

~Our first day begins on the **Mount of Olives overlooking the Temple Mount**, the **Dome of the Rock**, the **Golden Gate** and the **Kidron Valley**. Yehuda will share a marvelous presentation of the Biblical and historical events related to **Jerusalem**. His **Historical Overview** covers pre-Biblical **Jerusalem**, thru the **Hebrew Scriptures** and **New Testament** up to present day **Israel**.
